**Sub: Extension of Discounted Energy Rate Scheme (DERS)-Reg.**

**Preamble:**

1. The Commission, in its Tariff Order dated 09.06.2021 has approved Discounted Energy Rate Scheme (DERS) for HT consumers considering the Surplus Power situation during monsoon/off season period from July to December 2021, as per the terms and condition stipulated in the said Tariff Order.
2. BESCOM, HESCOM and GESCOM, in order to retain open access consumers who have already availed this scheme, have requested the Commission for extension of DERS Scheme up to March 2022.
3. As per the power availability projections made by SLDC/PCKL and submitted by BESCOM, in its letter dated 08.12.2021, surplus energy is available for the period from January, 2022 to March, 2022.

The Commission, keeping in view, the projected surplus power availability and the request of the ESCOMs to extend the DERS scheme, in order to sell the surplus power by encouraging the HT consumers to consume more power, over and above the base consumption, decides to continue the DERS scheme for further period of three months up to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.


Hence the following order:




ORDER

The Commission, by considering the request made by the ESCOMs and to encourage sales to the HT Consumers, to make use of the Surplus Energy availability as projected by SLDC/PCKL, hereby approves to extend the Discounted Energy Rate Scheme (DERS), for a further period of three months from January, 2022 to March, 2022, subject to terms and conditions as stipulated in the Tariff Order dated 09.06.2021.


