Corrigendum to Tariff Orders 2023 dated 12th May, 2023**Order**

The Commission has issued the Tariff Orders 2023 in respect of Annual Performance Review for FY22 & approval of revised Annual Revenue Requirement for FY24 & Revision of Retail Supply Tariff for FY24 for the ESCOMs namely BESCO, MESCOM, CESC, HESCO and GESCOM on 12.05.2023. The Commission has noticed that there are inadvertent errors required to be corrected in the said Order with regards to wheeling charges discussed in the Order. Hence, the Commission hereby issues the following corrections to the said Order:



Further, in case of injection is at LT or HT and drawal is at EHT, then as per the tariff Order the drawal ESCOM's wheeling charges and losses have to be considered, even


~~though drawal ESCOM's network is not used. This inadvertent error is to be corrected,~~
therefore the following shall be the charges in case of injection at LT or HT network of ESCOM and drawal is at EHT network of transmission licensee:

1. If injection is at LT and drawal is at EHT, the transmission charge in cash as determined in the Transmission Tariff Orders shall be payable to KPTCL, in addition to accounting of transmission losses and total wheeling charges (LT+HT) of injection ESCOM shall be payable only to the injection ESCOM where the power is injected, in addition to accounting of the injection ESCOM's technical losses.
2. If injection is at HT and drawal is at EHT, the transmission charge in cash as determined in the Transmission Tariff Orders shall be payable to KPTCL, in addition to accounting of transmission losses and HT network wheeling charges of injection ESCOM shall be payable only to the injection ESCOM where the power is injected, in addition to accounting of the injection ESCOM's HT technical losses.


